²⁰ He replied, "Because you have so **little faith**.





Knowing God's will Do we really want to know?

5 Steps

1- Pray and search Scripture. Ask for the Holy Spirit - wisdom

2- Confess any know Sin to the Holy Spirit - tell on yourself

3- Counsel SEAL Team brother or spiritual Mentor

4- Watch the Circumstances - God minded

5- Do what you feel you want to do! Trust in God's Character

The Word of God: *Promise, Precept or Proverb?*

Proverb: A proverb is a general principle that when generally applied will bring a general result. It is not binding

Precept: A precept is a truth stated in absolute terms.

Promise: A oath / word given that must be fulfilled by God. Hebrews 6:17-18 God cannot lie. It is confirmed by other Scripture
